Philosophy and Objectives

Philosophy:

The philosophy of the player evaluation process is to provide an open and fair means of ensuring that players are given the opportunity to play at a level and environment where they can maximize the development of their skills and enjoyment of the game.

Kids enjoy the game and develop their skills the most when playing with others of similar ability.

Objectives:

- To provide a fair and impartial assessment of a players total hockey skills, attitude and coachability.
- To ensure that all players have a reasonable opportunity of being selected to a team appropriate to their skill level.
- To allow coaches the opportunity and flexibility to select a team based on their own coaching philosophy and the assessment of the players skills, attitude and coachability.
- To provide uniformity and consistency in the evaluation process within each level.
- To provide constructive feedback with the purpose of providing the players with tangible information as to support their continued development.
