



City of Fort Saskatchewan Arena Restriction

Updated Oct 17, 2021

Effective Monday Sept 20, 2021 the City of Fort Saskatchewan is implementing the [Restrictions Exemption Program \(REP\)](#) in City facilities.

[Mandatory masing and physical distancing guidelines remain in place.](#)

Youth Sports

Players

- If a youth under 18 years of age is accessing a City of Fort Saskatchewan recreation facility with the REP in place for the sole purpose of taking part in a youth activity, they would **NOT** need to provide proof of vaccination status, physician note, or negative test. Youth participating in sport, fitness, recreation, and performance activities must screen for symptoms, maintain 2-metres distancing and wear a mask (except while engaged in physical activity).
- Face masks are required in all indoor public spaces, except while being physically active

Spectators

- Individuals 12 years and older must show one of the acceptable options for proof of vaccination if they wished to **spectate or use any other amenity** in the facility. If youth are spectating, proof of vaccination, medical exemption or paid negative COVID-19 test is required.
- Face masks are required in all indoor public spaces, except while being physically active

Coaches

- Adults (Coaches, trainers, volunteers, and spectators) are required to have proof of vaccination to enter City of Fort Saskatchewan REP Facilities.
- Face masks are required in all indoor public spaces, except while being physically active

Proof of vaccination

- Show government-issued proof of vaccination. This can be a vaccine report, MyAlberta health record or vaccine card. All proof must have the name clearly visible and can be presented in paper or digital format.
- full vaccination (**14 days from second dose**) is required starting October 25
- Note: Proof of vaccination must be shown upon each visit. Vaccination proof will only be viewed and will not be collected or saved at this time.
- If proof of vaccination is not possible, a negative privately-purchased COVID-19 test obtained within the last 72 hours must be presented. All proof must have the name and date of the test clearly visible.

Dressing rooms & Entry /Exit times



- players wear masks in dressing room until they put their helmet on and are ice ready.
- After the ice time please have players put mask back on as soon as their helmet is off
- Showers are open
- **Players are NOT to enter the dressing room more then:**
 - **AAA/AA teams – 60 Min,**
 - **U13-18 – 45 Min,**
 - **U7-U9 30 min.**
