Parents are expected to lead by example and act in a positive manner while at all hockey-related events. Parents are a critical part of the team's success; the coaching staff requires their full cooperation and support. Parents agree to:

- Abide by the rules and policies set forth by FSMH, League(s), Hockey Alberta, and Hockey Canada and the principles of fair play and the spirit of the game.
- Avoid making any negative or critical comments about players or parents on your team or others. Never ridicule or yell at any child for making mistakes.
- Be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice, or team event.
- Refrain from comments or behaviour that is disrespectful, offensive, harassing, abusive, racist, or sexist. Any behaviour, which constitutes harassment, abuse, or bullying, will not be tolerated.
- Observe the "24 Hour" rule when providing communication to the coach or the association(s).
- Do Not enter the changing room unless invited to enter by a member of the coaching staff.
- Ensure all financial commitments are made on time unless prior arrangements are made.
- Avoid behaviour that brings the Association or the sport of hockey into disrepute including, but not limited to, abuse of any intoxicating substance and/or supporting the consumption of intoxicating substances by minors.
- Be responsible for your guest at the rink in the stands
- All FSMH members will be accountable for ensuring that their behaviour is appropriate and aligned with our Values and Codes of Conduct at all FSMH-related events.

Failure to comply will lead to sanctions including but not limited to; attendance at association events and membership. status being revoked.
