

FSMH PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT 2024-25

As a parent, it is essential to lead by example and maintain a positive attitude at all hockey-related events. Your involvement is crucial to the team's success, and we appreciate your full cooperation and support. By participating in this program, you agree to the following:

- Adhere to Policies: Follow the rules and policies established by FSMH, the league(s), Hockey Alberta, and Hockey Canada while upholding the values of fair play and the spirit of the game.
- Positive Communication: Refrain from making negative or critical comments about players, parents, coaches, volunteers or on-ice or off-ice officials, whether from your team or others. Never ridicule or shout at anyone for making mistakes.
- Be a Role Model: Set a positive example for your child by promoting sportsmanship. Show respect and courtesy and provide positive support to all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at games, practices, or team events.
- Show Respect: Avoid behaviour that brings the Association or the sport of hockey into disrepute, including, but not limited to, abuse of any intoxicating substance and/or supporting the consumption of intoxicating substances by minors.
- **Respect the Sport:** Avoid actions that could damage the reputation of the Association or the sport of hockey, including substance abuse and supporting underage drinking.
- Guest Conduct: Be responsible for the behavior of your guests in the stands.
- 24-Hour Rule: Allow a 24-hour cooling-off period before communicating with the coach or association about any concerns.
- Restricted Access: Do not enter the changing room unless invited by a coaching staff.
- Financial Responsibility: Ensure all financial commitments are fulfilled on time unless prior arrangements have been made.
- Accountability: All FSMH members must ensure that their behavior aligns with our values and the Code of Conduct at all FSMH-related events.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in sanctions, including restrictions on attendance at association events and potential revocation of membership status.
