

2011 & 2012 – U15 RAC PLAYERS – TRYOUT PROCESS

1. What level to start at

- a. 2011 & 2012 players have the option to start at U15AAA or U15AA
- b. Non-resident players can start at either AAA or AA if they reside in both the AAA and AA draw zones. If a player only resides in the AAA draw zone, they must register for AAA. If the player only resides in the AA draw zone, they must register for AA tryouts.

2. **Tryout fees**

- **a.** If a player starts at AAA, a \$370 tryout fee will be collected at registration.
- **b.** A \$200 tryout fee will be collected upon registration if a player starts at
- c. Only one tryout fee is collected per player. No additional tryout fees are due if the player trickles down to AA or tier.

3. Resident players

a. 2011 & 2012 Resident players

U15AAA tryout

- Successful—Your tryout process is over, and the U15AAA head coach will contact you with your next practice time.
- ii. Unsuccessful: You will be notified of your first tryout time with U15AA.

U15AA Tryout (Players have the option to start here)

- i. Successful —Your tryout process is over, and the U15AA head coach will contact you with your next practice time.
- Unsuccessful—FSMH will notify you if your registration for the U15 tier is successful based on FSMH registration capacity.

U15 Tier 3rd party evaluations

2011 & 2012 Non-Resident players 4.

U15AAA tryout

- Successful—Your tryout process is over, and the U15AAA head coach will contact you with your next practice time.
- ii. Unsuccessful and resides in the AA draw zone - The player will be notified of their first tryout time with U15AA.
- iii. Unsuccessful and NOT AA draw zone - Player will return to their home association.



U15AA Tryout (Players in the AA draw zone have the option to start here)

- i. Successful Your tryout process is over, and the U15AA head coach will contact you with your next practice time.
- **ii.** Unsuccessful player will return to their home association to continue tryouts.
