COMMITMENT

These team standards help players and families enjoy a positive, fun, and competitive season. They reflect FSMH's values of respect, development, and community.

COMMUNICATION WITH PARENTS

Clear and respectful communication builds trust and sets the tone for the season.

- First Point of Contact Parents with concerns should reach out to the Team
 Manager first.
 - The manager will share information with the coaching staff, who will decide if a player/parent/coach meeting is needed.
- **24-Hour Rule** Concerns will not be discussed immediately after games. A 24-hour cooling-off period allows everyone to reflect.

ATTENDANCE

- If a player will miss a practice, game, or team event, families must update TeamSnap and notify the coaching staff.
- Consistent attendance builds team chemistry and supports skill development

PRACTICES

- Players must arrive fully equipped. Missing required equipment (e.g., neck guard) means they **cannot participate**.
- Bring a **filled personal water bottle**. Sharing bottles is not permitted.
- Be **fully dressed and ready 10 minutes before ice time** to allow for team discussion or warm-up.





GAMES

- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior with both home and away jerseys and socks.
- Show discipline on the ice and respect teammates, opponents, and officials.
- **Zero tolerance** for bullying, discrimination, or disrespect.
- If penalized, players must skate directly to the penalty box and avoid debating calls.
- Coaches, players, and parents will always speak to officials in a **calm, courteous** manner.

DRESSING ROOM CONDUCT

- No roughhousing (pushing, wrestling, shooting pucks, throwing tape, etc.).
- No spitting on the floor.
- No inappropriate language, swearing, or discriminatory remarks.

 Breaches may lead to a parent/coach meeting and follow-up actions

CELL PHONES

 Cell phones and cameras are not permitted in dressing rooms or during team activities

PARENTS

- Lead by example—show positivity and sportsmanship at all hockey events.
- Support team volunteers and coaches; your cooperation is key to success.
- Follow FSMH's Parent Code of Conduct and all FSMH and Hockey Alberta policies.
- Concerns should be raised through proper channels and within the 24-hour rule.
