

FSMH JERSEY CARE

Jersey Care Guidelines

To maintain the quality and longevity of FSMH jerseys, each team is provided two sets of jerseys (home and away) and two Association garment bags at the start of the season. The Head Coach or Team Manager is responsible for collecting the jerseys and distributing them to the players.

Tip: distribute by size rather than jersey number for the best fit.

Jersey Manager Role

Each team must designate one or two Jersey Managers to care for the jerseys and garment bags throughout the season. Their attention to detail helps protect Association property and ensures every player looks game-ready.

Jersey Manager Responsibilities

A. Care & Use

- Oversee the care and maintenance of all team jerseys and garment bags.
- Ensure jerseys are worn for games only.
- Arrange for any name bars, captain/assistant “C” or “A” designations to be added. Enhance it is the only approved vendor to modify jerseys.

B. Transportation & Storage

- Jerseys must travel to games on hangers inside the garment bags—not inside hockey bags.
- Players must not take jerseys home.
- After games, used jerseys may be placed in a small bin for transport to the Jersey Manager’s home for washing.

C. Cleaning & Maintenance

- Wash jerseys regularly throughout the season.
- Follow these washing instructions:



- Turn inside out and wash in cold water
- Hang to dry completely before returning to the garment bag
- Do not use bleach or fabric softeners

Optional Service: Local laundries may be used if preferred. Teams are responsible for any costs.

D. End-of-Season Return

- Jerseys and garment bags must be returned in the same condition as issued.
- FSMH equipment directors will reach out with equipment return dates
- Missing or damaged jerseys will be charged to the team at the Association's replacement cost.
